Subject: SFS 15-74 Louisiana's CEP Data Spreadsheet 2015 Report

Listed below is the link to the USDA Memo SP 21-2014(v.2) - Community Eligibility Provision (CEP): Guidance and Q&As-Revised. The memo requires all potential sponsors to be notified of their district-wide eligibility and to be provided CEP guidance in the following categories:

- LEAs with a district-wide identified student percentage of at least 40%
- LEAs with a district-wide identified student percentage greater than or equal to 30 % but less than 40%
- Schools with an identified student percentage of at least 40%
- Schools with an identified student percentage greater than or equal to 30% less than 40%

The following color codes indicate the percentages of identified students:

- The green highlighted areas indicates sites with 40% or greater
- The orange highlighted areas indicates sites with 30% or greater, but less than 40%
- The white areas indicates sites less than 30% system wide
